On Tuesday, September 10, the Irvine City Council voted to moved forward with building We did it! the Great Park by negotiating a deal with FivePoint Communities who increased their offer to \$176 million to build a 668 acres of park development including one of the preeminent youth sports complexes in the country for baseball, soccer, tennis, golf and swimming, a 178 Acre Wildlife Corridor and 80 Acre park & recreation complex.

The entire Build the Great Park Now committee wishes to thank Mayor Steven Choi, Mayor Pro Tem Jeff Lalloway and Council Members Larry Agran, Beth Krom and Christina Shea for their unanimous yes vote. We would also like to thank the more than 2,000 Irvine residents who signed our petition online and at sporting events throughout the city, emailed the city council and especially the hundreds who attended the council meeting.

Even with all this great forward motion, we are not done yet.

Our next stop is the Planning Commission, followed, we hope, by a formal approval by the City Council. We hope to have the final city council vote finalized by the end of the year.
